The loss of CD4 cells makes it difficult for the body to fight off infections, illnesses, and certain cancers. In such a situation, awareness is necessary to prevent it.

On December 1, B.Ed trainees organized an awareness program for AIDS prevention, the sole objective of which is to control AIDS.

said that- we can also propagate the fact that getting tested to check HIV is a common thing to do. The only way to identify a HIV virus is through testing. Beginning treatment early for HIV can increase the chances to live a full, healthy and productive life. There are also free and confidential tests available.

#### OUTCOMES:-

India has demonstrated an overall reduction of 57% in the annual new HIV infections among adult population from 2.74 lakh in 2000 to 1.16 lakh in 2011, reflecting the impact of various interventions and scaled-up prevention strategies under the National AIDS Control Programme (NACP). In such a situation, by doing such programs, this problem will decrease in the coming days.
